Summer Scholars is a community-based literacy program serving elementary school age children in NE Denver who are reading and writing below grade level. The after school program is focused on building reading skills. Students will rotate through three different stations – reading, cognitive development, and computer phonics – all focused on fluency, phonemic awareness and phonics.

Summer Scholars is currently recruiting exceptional teachers for the reading station during the 2008-09 after school program. Classes are held twice weekly (Monday/Wednesday, Tuesday/Thursday or some sites have Fridays). Classes will vary from site to site and will be held within the hours of 3:15 – 5:45 pm, depending upon the school dismissal time. Teachers' hours are generally from 3:30 – 5:00 pm or 4:00 – 5:30 pm. The program runs through end of April.

Scholars After School is located in these schools: Ashley, Columbine, Dora Moore, Fairmont, Harrington, Montclair, Smith, Swansea, Valdez and Whittier.

- Work with small groups of children (up to 6 at a time)
- Teaching is tailored to each student after an individual assessment is completed
- Set goals for individual students based on DIBELS assessment data, or other assessment information (DRA, QRI). *If you have had training in DIBELS, please note that in the training section of the application.*
- Use Summer Scholars' literacy instruction, small group instruction, and schedule
- Use the curriculum provided by Summer Scholars
- Summer Scholars will provide paid Training

Minimum Requirements

- Current teachers license (preferred)
- Elementary school experience
- In good standing with Denver Public Schools and Summer Scholars
- Attendance at mandatory training sessions

Compensation

Teachers will be paid \$20/hr for direct instruction for 2 to 3 hours of instruction a week, depending upon the school assignment. Training and planning is also \$20/hr. Teachers will be paid for 1 hour of planning a week.
